Description:

Criteria:

- 1. Must hold an AACUSS membership at the time of application.
- 2. Membership must be current at the time of the annual conference.
- 3. Consideration/preference will be given to members/applicants who fit some or all the following criteria:
 - a. First-time attendees
 - b. Professionals who will be presenting at the conference.
 - c. Those who demonstrate financial need.
 - d. There will be at least one conference registration grant awarded per Atlantic province.
 - e. Identify as an Indigenous and/or equity-deserving member of AACUSS.

How to Apply:

- 1. Complete the application form.
- 2. Submit a personal statement of no more than 250 words describing financial need and how your attendance will impact your professional development.

Grant Details:

- 1. <u>Conference Registration Grant</u> The successful applicant(s) will receive conference registration for the upcoming conference.
- 2. <u>Travel Grant</u> The successful applicant(s) will receive up to \$500 depending on the mode of travel and location of the conference. This amount will be determined by the Awards and Grants Committee.
- 3. Successful applicants will be contacted at least one month before the conference to allow for planning and preparation.
- 4. Successful grant recipients will be recognized at the Awards and Grants Ceremony.
